Born in the heart of Pennsylvania Dutch country, Beverly Lewis has authored more than eighty books—published in eleven languages worldwide. A keen interest in her mother’s Plain heritage has inspired Beverly to write many Amish-related novels, beginning with *The Shunning*, which sold more than one million copies and was made into an Original Hallmark Channel movie. Her latest novel is *The Mercy*, the third volume in her Rose Trilogy.

Writing started as a coping mechanism for Beverly Lewis. “My mother was dying of cancer when I was little,” Lewis says. “The doctors said she had only six months to live, and I was always writing my thoughts in little journals. I would create these stories about exotic places, the different worlds I was juxtaposed against growing up in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and being around the Amish families my dad knew.”

But what could’ve been a tragic childhood, God turned around for good. Beverly’s mother lived to be eighty-four

(the miracle story went into her book *The Sunroom*), and her curiosity with the Amish has spawned numerous best-selling books including *The Shunning*, *The Redemption of Sarah Cain*, and her latest series The Rose Trilogy. Before she was ever published in book-length, however, she wrote on assignment for magazines. “I loved it,” she says. “I was also doing short fiction for kids and teens in the *Brio* and *Breakaway* days. Back then being published in *Highlights for Children* was a big goal of mine. It took lots of attempts, but I finally [achieved it].”

Beverly’s first published book was a novel for teen girls. Nineteen months after she submitted it to Zondervan’s slush pile, she got a call saying they wanted to publish it, but they wanted a whole series. This surprised Beverly, but she readily agreed. *Best Friend, Worst Enemy* was released in 1993 and became book one in the fourteen volume Holly’s Heart series, now published by Bethany House. “I didn’t have an agent,” Beverly adds. “I actually sold my first sixty books on my own, with the help of my husband who eventually became my agent and manager.”



It wasn't too long before Beverly's pen turned to writing stories about the Amish. First came her Summerhill Secrets series, set near where she grew up in the small town of Neffsville, PA. But then the story which had been simmering in her heart since she was eleven had to be told.

"Many of my stories are based on the spunkiness of my maternal grandmother," Beverly says. "She was raised Old Order

blockbuster Amish fiction novels and selling well over a million copies. Beverly knew it was special early on. "This warm, amazing feeling would come over me whenever I would work on it," she says. "I felt it was something to be protected and taken care of, to be held close to me until it was ready to be released."

One of the things that originally fascinated Beverly about the Amish was their

all their dear spiritual values and attitudes toward their tradition—a lot of them really are strong believers. Others are just embracing what they know, but they're the most honest, kindhearted, generous people you will ever want to meet. We can learn a lot from them."

Most authors dream of seeing just one of their books made into a movie, but Beverly has been blessed to have two turned into feature films. 2007's *Saving Sarah Cain* was based on her novel *The Redemption of Sarah Cain*, but the filmmakers freely adapted many aspects of the story to better fit the big screen. Beverly understood this needed to be done and had the chance to approve everything.

When it came time for *The Shunning* movie to be made, she expected there would be many surprises in it too, but there weren't. They stuck very closely to the novel because it read like a movie script in the minds of the filmmakers, which Beverly takes as a compliment.


"Michael Landon Jr. sent us the uncut edition," she says. "I was trying to be open-minded and not love it too much. I tried to come at it like a typical viewer, but that's kind of impossible to do because I'm so

Mennonite and eventually was ex-communicated and shunned when she didn't marry the man her father and the bishop thought she should. She was incredibly courageous for following her heart and what she believed was God's call in her life. *The Shunning* is loosely based on her story. I think the books that simmer in me the longest are the best," she adds with a laugh.

The Shunning changed the face of Christian publishing, becoming one of the first

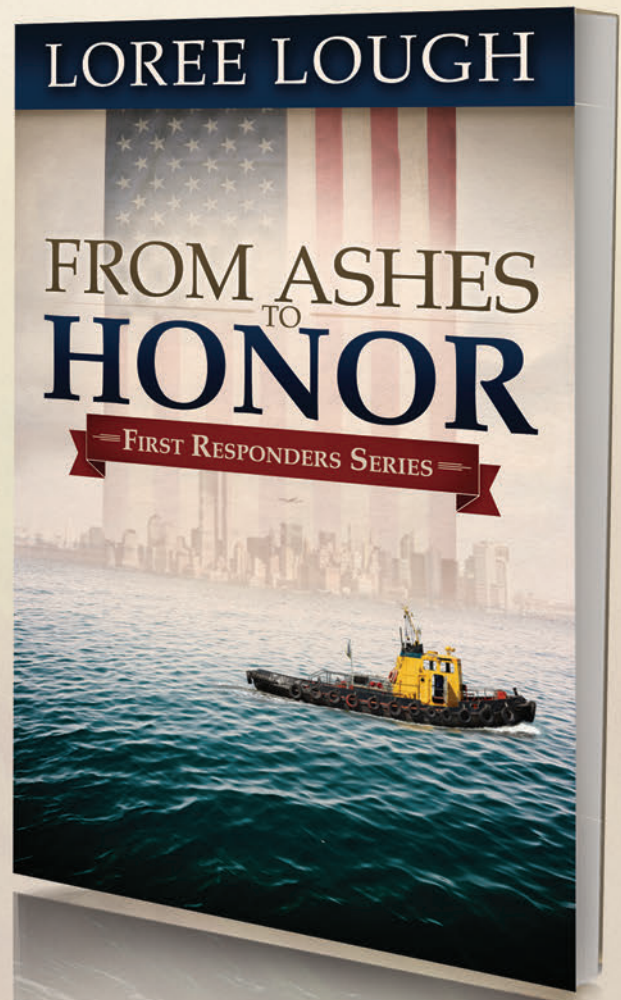
great sense of belonging. "Every child is absolutely adored and loved," she says. "There's a lot of cherishing going on, even when there are children who are born disabled or with special needs. close to the story. I remember being so incredibly moved. ‘That’s my Katie!’ I said, so excited. I had to hold myself down when I wrote back with my comments. It was surreal. My husband has watched it ten times on Hallmark!”

Beverly’s new series, *The Rose Trilogy*, which concludes with *The Mercy*, again takes readers into the heart of Amish country with a storyline stemming from two separate ideas. “The concept of foster care among the Amish community intrigued me,” she says. “There are Amish families who have actually been able to adopt Englishers children and raise them in the Amish church and faith. Also, there aren’t many of them, but there are some young Amish women who have impulsively married outside their communities and regretted it, especially

after having a child and then experiencing the push and pull of how to raise the child to mesh with their traditional, conservative upbringing when the father, their husband, is pushing for a worldly influence. These two storylines were really strong in me. I try to keep my plots nice and fresh. Just because I keep writing Amish settings doesn’t mean they’re going to be the same old, same old.”

When it comes to the actual process of writing, Beverly is thoroughly devoted. She admits to often working until she falls off the chair into bed. “I’m just crazy!” she says, laughing. “I start in the morning and edit

everything that doesn’t look great in the light of day. In the afternoon I work on marketing, answering fan mail, Facebook, and even snail mail. Then in the evening or later afternoon I try to outline what I’m going to write next. I set aside about two and a half months to do my writing marathon. Then I have a week off. After that I go on tour for two weeks and come back to do revisions, take a little break, and then start again. I do this every six months.

“I don’t know if I’ll ever live to write all the stories I have,” she concludes. “Not all of them are Amish. I have to write what’s passionate for me. I never wrote for the market; I wrote my heart.”

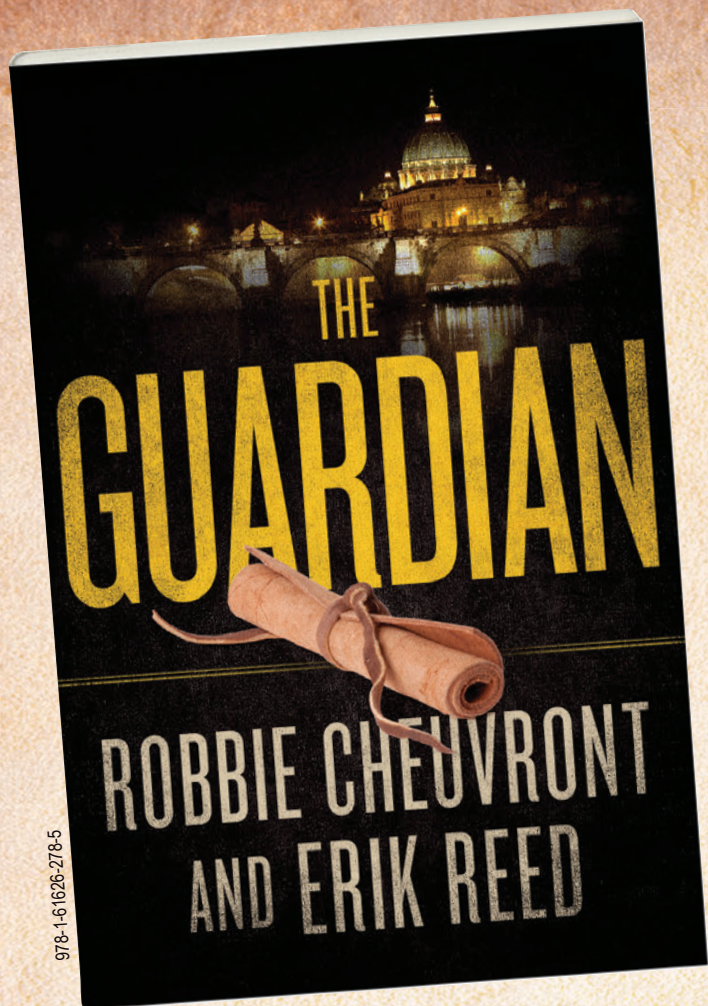

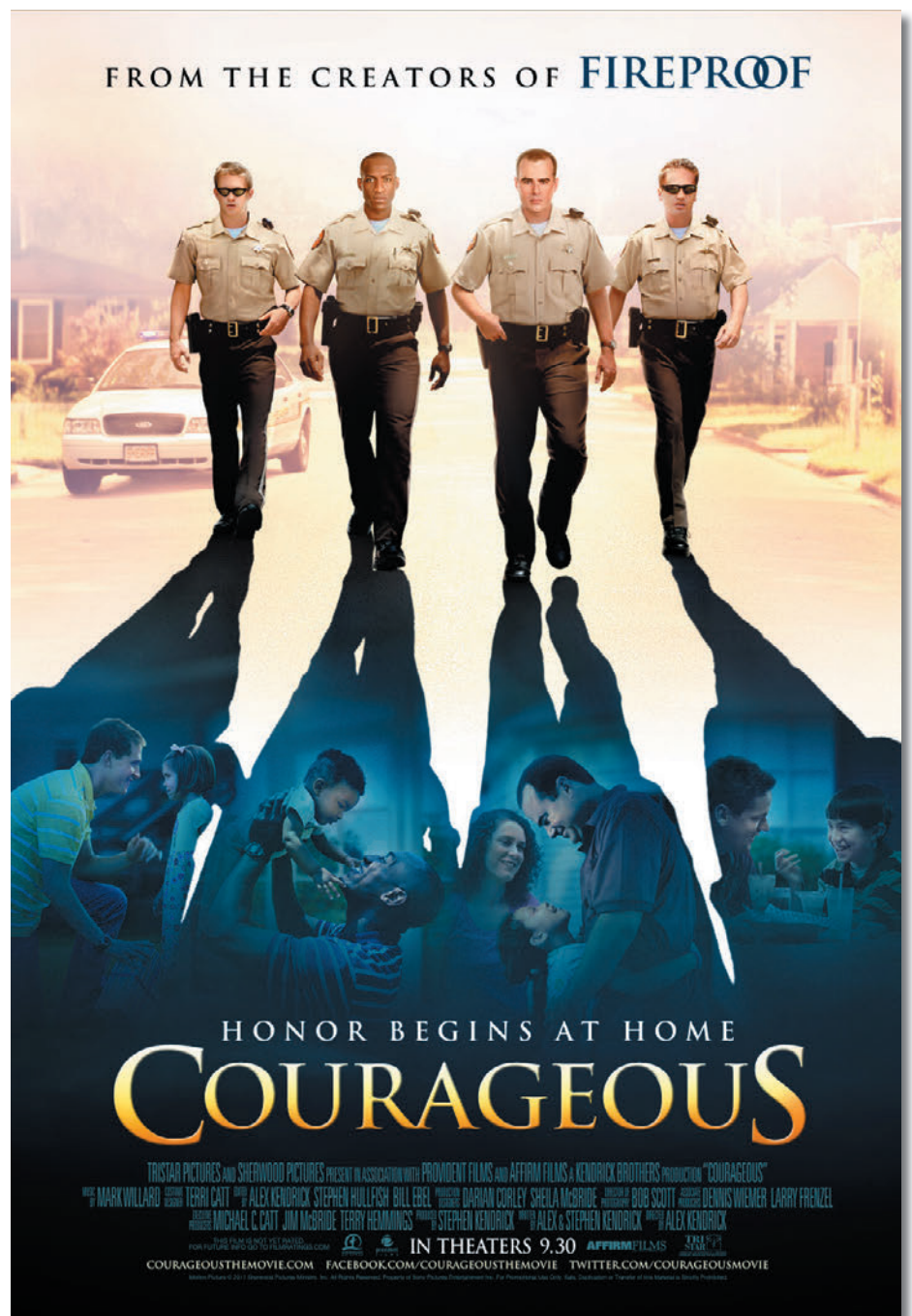
Courageous, the latest film from Sherwood Pictures, aims to do for fatherhood what their film *Fireproof* did for marriage.

When Alex and Stephen Kendrick made their first movie *Flywheel* for \$20,000, they had no idea their little film would change the face of Christian moviemaking. They didn't even know if they'd shoot another movie. But since 2003 God has led the brothers and their church, Sherwood Baptist, to release ground breaking films like *Facing the Giants* and *Fireproof*, which became the highest grossing independent film of 2008. Now Sherwood Pictures is set to impact culture once again with the theatrical release of *Courageous*, a cop drama about four police officers who get a crash course in fatherhood.

Ken Bevel, who plays Officer Nathan Hayes in the film, explains Sherwood's approach to filmmaking. "Every idea is bathed in prayer," he says. "We're trying to stay away from the stereotype that we're cranking out movies and aren't really interested in the impact they're making. There is such a thing as a good idea and a God idea. A good idea for everybody else is for Sherwood to

make more movies, but we always ask ourselves if God wants us to."

Thankfully for viewers, the resounding answer after *Fireproof* was "yes." The result is a film Sherwood hopes will turn the hearts of men to their children and the hearts of children to their fathers. Fatherhood is a subject that especially hits home for Bevel whose dad started abusing alcohol and drugs when he was young, sending him into a tailspin. "There was no one there to help me be a man," Bevel says, "or show me how to be a husband and father. No one to tell me about the principles of God and how He can be our sustainer.

“I’ve seen the effects bad marriages and bad relationships can have on a child. I’ve lived it. I can identify with this movie on that level and as a father myself now too. Often you’re going through life thinking you’re a good dad. But do you really understand what a good dad is? Do you really know what God says about being a father?”

Which isn’t to say *Courageous* is only a movie for dads. “We all need to ask ourselves about our purpose,” Bevel points out. “What has God called you to, and what does Scripture say about it? Everything in this movie is pointing people to the cross.”

“Some see our movies and think the church is raking in all this dough,” Bevel adds. “But this process takes an enormous amount of commitment and people staying on their knees praying. I know I’m one of the people who’s seen on the screen, but there are thousands of people in the background. It’s a huge undertaking, but the great thing about this is the unity of the group. People are coming together because they believe God has ordained this and has allowed the church to do this for a season. There’s no jealousy. Everybody’s bringing together their gifts and talents to glorify God.”

In a world where every emotion but fear has been eradicated, and the primary objective of every person is to follow Order, a vial of blood holds the key to life. From the minds and hearts of Ted Dekker and Tosca Lee comes *Forbidden* (Center Street), the first novel in The Books of Mortals series—a sweeping saga set in a grim, medieval future.

Already a best-selling author many times over, Ted writes adrenaline-packed thrillers and allegory-filled fantasies. “I’ve upped the ante and written this epic with Tosca Lee,” Ted says. “The result speaks for itself. We both wrote every chapter, which took twice the time, something I’ve never done before.”

Tosca’s novels *Demon* and *Havah* (B&H) shattered barriers in Christian publishing and she quickly gained a following. She says it’s the duo’s complementary strengths that make this partnership work. “Anyone who reads Ted’s books knows he’s particularly brilliant when it comes to pacing, plot, action,” she says. “Those are very classic Dekker trademarks. The things that I’m known for tend to be language, prose, description.”

“Her stunning prose with my native, no prisoners storytelling has created a singular voice,” Ted adds.

“It’s very difficult for us, even now, to go back and say, ‘I wrote this. I wrote this sentence, this is mine,’” Tosca put in. “Every now and then I can see a phrase or a word, and I can remember penning it, but it’s very, very difficult anymore to know who wrote what.”

Tosca shares how this unique collaboration came about: “If you look at the kind of things he’s

interested in thematically, they’re very similar to the kind of things that interest me. The same kinds of stories move us.” Emails about their writing led to the suggestion of writing a series together. “The idea was to do something that neither one of us could produce alone. Otherwise, what’s the point?”

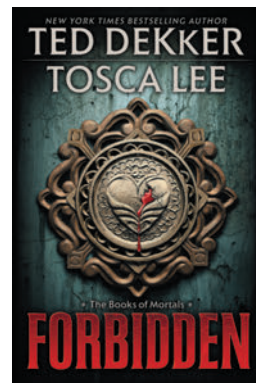
The adventure they created commences when a young artisan is given an ancient vial of blood and a cryptic vellum. Forced to flee, Rom drinks the blood and is flooded by unfamiliar passions. Wonder. Sorrow. Love. He realizes the rest of the world is dead, feeling only fear, and begins a journey to bring back that which is forbidden: true life.

“At the very beginning of this project, we started with the theme,” Tosca says—but each author came at the same theme from slightly different angles. “I know that this series is a chance for Ted to examine God’s greatest creation, which is humanity. What does it mean to be made in God’s image? For me, it was: What does it mean to be fully human? What does it mean to be truly alive?”

Ted elaborates on the series title, The Books of Mortals. “Mortal simply means ‘Alive’ and as such belonging to the world of the living, not the dead. It’s a provocative word, because it also can mean ‘severe’ or ‘dangerous’ and being truly mortal is a dangerous thing.”

“I am so grateful to Ted’s readers, for embracing me and this project,” Tosca says. “One note from one reader will carry me for days.”

The next two books in the series, *Mortal* and *Sovereign*, come out in 2012. “Initially we intended on delivering the series over three years,” Ted says, “but the enthusiasm has grown so quickly behind closed doors that the publisher called us, begging us to allow them to release all three in one year.” **FF**

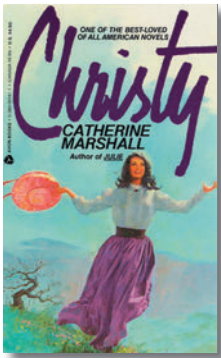

*The Christy Awards: Honoring
Exceptional Christian Fiction*

The Christy Awards were handed out July 11 in Atlanta, Georgia. Named after the groundbreaking novel by Catherine Marshall, the awards honor the best in Christian fiction.

The popularity of Christian fiction has exploded in recent years—but the concept is certainly not new. In the Bible, the prophet Nathan used a fictional story about a family’s favorite lamb to confront King David with his sin. Jesus, like many rabbis of his time, used fictional stories, known as parables, to teach and challenge His listeners, setting the example for Christian novelists today. And then there’s the first modern-day Christian novel—*The Pilgrim’s Progress* by John Bunyan—published in February 1678, and still a popular read.

Though Christian fiction isn’t new, it has gained not only in popularity but in respectability as well. And for the past eleven years, The Christy Awards have been doing their part to raise that profile. The Christy Awards were handed out Monday, July 11, at the International Christian Retail Show in Atlanta, Georgia.

The idea for the awards came up in 1999 when an editorial meeting at Bethany House

Publishers turned to discussing the need for an award to recognize memorable fiction that might not attain bestseller status. Soon, those present were exploring ways to also bring further awareness to the breadth and quality of novels published for the Christian market, and to nurture and encourage creativity and quality in the writing and publishing of Christian novels.

Carol Johnson, then VP of Editorial at Bethany House and a founding member of the Christy Advisory Board, chaired that original meeting. “We thought Catherine Marshall’s *Christy* would provide a good headline as representative of the genre,” she says, explaining the name behind the annual fiction awards. Following that meeting, she called some industry friends at other publishing houses. “And we met that year for a discussion of the possibilities.”

An advisory board was made up of representatives of Christian publishers and

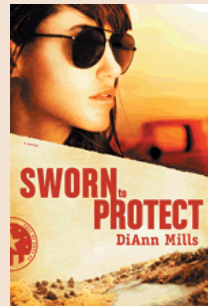
retailers to guide and expand the initiative. The first Christy Award banquet was held the following summer, during the Christian Booksellers Association retail show in 2000. That first banquet honored books in six categories.

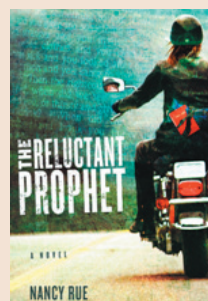

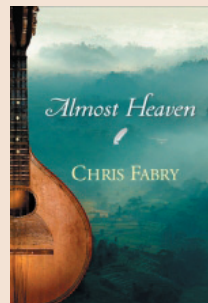

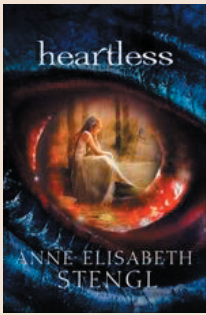
about God and His love and interaction with humankind throughout history,” says Donna Kehoe, tapped by the founding group to run that first program. Eleven years later, Kehoe serves as executive director of the Christy Awards. “When a panel of judges gives a novel a Christy Award, they’re saying that the author has skillfully interwoven

characterization, plot, theme, and other criteria for a good novel in this work—and that’s something to celebrate.”

Over the years, the Christy Awards has grown into a gala event that is one of the highlights of the annual International Christian Retail Show. In fact, it is nearly impossible today to imagine ICRS without the Christy

Awards. “Among the awards for excellence in Christian fiction,” notes Cynthia Ruchti, author and board member of American Christian Fiction Writers, “the Christy Awards hold a revered spot.”

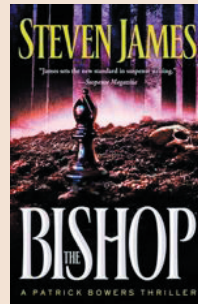
ACFW president Margaret Daley agrees. “The Christy Awards are the industry’s way of acknowledging exceptional Christian fiction.” **FF**

KATHY TYERS

SPACE FIRE

BY KATIE HART



With her original Firebird trilogy, author Kathy Tyers is said to have invented the Christian science fiction genre in the modern era. Following a long sabbatical, she returns to fiction—and to the Firebird story.

For Christians who are fans of science fiction, author Kathy Tyers made history in 1986. That was the year she launched a groundbreaking science fiction epic with *Firebird*, followed quickly by *Fusion Fire*.

A space opera with parallels to ancient Israel, the titles were originally published by general market publisher Bantam Spectra—but when Kathy took the books (along with the third volume, *Crown of Fire*) to Christian publisher Bethany House, she found the freedom to revise the books and tell the story exactly how she

wanted. “Writing for Bethany House gave me the opportunity to bring forward the spiritual undertones that had always been there,” Kathy shares. “The Firebird series always was a conversion story.”

More than two decades after *Firebird*’s original publication, Marcher Lord Press has published *The Annotated Firebird*, a special three-in-one volume with added material, maps and notes from the author. “All along I have kept a very fat notebook of brainstorming ideas,” Kathy says. “Family trees, cultural ideas, Hebrew

word derivations and such. I went through and reread the Bantam and Bethany House versions of *Firebird*, *Fusion Fire*, and *Crown of Fire*, and just took notes of little things that popped into my head as I was reading it, memories from writing, and where nearly all the names came from.”

REACHING INTO SPACE

Kathy has enjoyed reading science fiction since she was a bright fifth grader looking in the junior high section of the public library. “I brought home a copy of Ben Bova’s *The Star*

Conquerors. I read it in one day, and just couldn't believe I had found something so new and wonderful."

Many years later, as a young mother, Kathy decided to try writing a science fiction novel of her own.

Her first book was *Firebird*—and she was already working on the sequel when she made her first sale.

After writing four novels for Bantam Books, Kathy was invited to write a *Star Wars* novel. Kathy eventually wrote two *Star Wars* novels, *The Truce at Bakura* and *Balance Point*.

But not everything was rosy. "My late husband was pretty much convinced that my writing secular science fiction was part of the problem. So I backed off, stopped reading it, stopped writing it, and told God if He was ever going to have me write science fiction again, He was going to have to make it plain to me and my husband."

He did. Kathy took a proposal for a contemporary women's series to a Christian writers' conference, but the very first editor she met with, Steve Laube, turned out to be a long-time fan of her science fiction novels. He championed her *Firebird* series and another rewritten novel, *Shivering World*, at Bethany House.

RETURN TO WRITING

Widowed in 2004, Kathy headed in 2006 to school for her

master's degree in Christianity and the arts. "I went to Regent College needing a rest, but also needing a kickstart if I was ever going to be writing again. One reason I chose Regent was that I could write a new novel as essentially my master's thesis."

Returning to novel writing was initially frightening. "Within a couple of weeks I pounded out one of the scenes for the first time, and I really was lost. Who was I to think that I could write?"

But she remembered that same doubt plagued earlier novels, and kept writing. "It was wonderful to have it confirmed at Regent College that all the arts, all of the things we do creatively, come to

us from our Creator, and they are good gifts for the building up of other people, besides just entertainment. So I was being encouraged about writing in general as I was writing. It was the perfect environment for me."

REBIRTH OF FIREBIRD

Now Kathy's *Firebird* series has found new life at Christian speculative fiction publisher Marcher Lord Press. Book four in the series, *Wind and Shadow*, releases fall 2011. "It's the next generation. I started with the assumption that *Firebird's* twin sons would follow very different paths, and sure enough, they did. It was fun to put them in an adventure together, along with

a young woman who grew up on the conquered world of Three Zed. She has a very evil background, but she was raised among Sentinels, so she is an interesting character." Book five is scheduled for 2012.

"The heart of my books is the characters," Kathy says. "I believe that every character is more complex than you could possibly put in a book. To find the aspect of that character that brings her or him to life and drives the plot forward is the spark of every book." **FF**

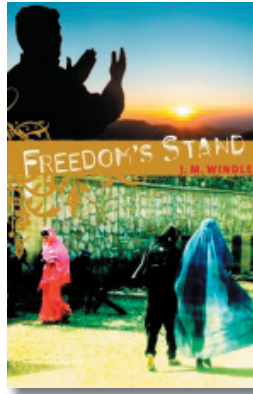

JEANETTE WINDLE

As the daughter of American missionaries growing up in the Colombian guerrilla zones and subsequently serving with her husband in the Bolivian mission field and on all five continents, Jeanette Windle has spent her whole life in the world of international missions. It comes as no surprise that her fiction is missions focused and grounded in her real life experiences. Jeanette's early adult novels, including *Crossfire*, *Firestorm* and *The DMZ* (Kregel), are set in South America with her most recent offerings, *Veiled Freedom* (Christy and CBA award finalist) and *Freedom's Stand* (Tyndale), in Afghanistan. Of her mission field experience Jeanette says, "I have been blessed to experience, in the darkest places, the overriding sovereignty of a loving God and the shining light that is the body of Christ. The stories I encountered along the way were so incredible that fiction was the only real way to bring them to life."

Veiled Freedom introduces a disillusioned Special Forces veteran, an idealistic relief worker, and an Afghan refugee whose stories continue in *Freedom's Stand*. Jeanette shares, "The three main characters are representative of the three main players I have encountered so often in this drama: the international military/State Department world, the international aid/humanitarian world, and the Afghan people themselves. I wanted readers to get a glimpse into each of these worlds, their point of view, and the interweaving issues as these worlds clash."

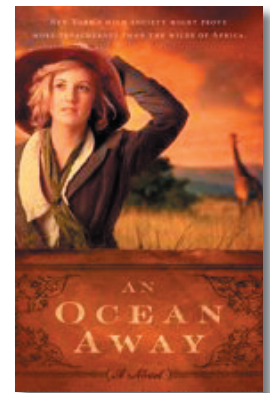
Jeanette's fiction reveals her desire to support her Christian brothers and sisters who are imprisoned or persecuted for their faith, not only in Afghanistan but across the planet, and she prays her readers will finish the book with an understanding of the true source of freedom. 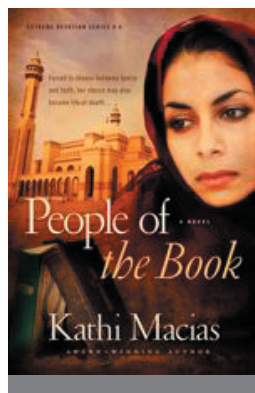
Kathi Macias – A 17-year-old came up to me after a book signing and said, “Mrs. Macias, I love the books in this series. They make me want to lead a noble life.” I nearly wept to think that God had touched this young man so deeply through my words.

only on God’s strength to make a difference in the refugee camp. Lisa’s historical novel, *An Ocean Away* (Summerside) reflects the same belief that faithfulness to God can move mountains. “There are numerous examples in the Bible of men and women who God called to serve Him in an extraordinary way through His power,” shares Lisa. “God calls us in the middle of our ordinary, run-of-the-mill, take-out-the-trash and drive-the-kids-to-school routine. So stop and ask yourself this one question. How do you see God calling you to make a difference in your world?”

Lisa hopes her novels remind readers they can have a positive impact for God no matter where they are living. “We are not all called to live overseas as missionaries, but we all can see those living near us who need God’s grace, forgiveness and love. It might be a hurting neighbour down the street, a lonely teen in your youth group, or a tired young mother in your apartment building. God can and does use ordinary people like you and me to do extraordinary things.”

Farah has to decide if she truly is willing to risk everything—her family, her comfortable home, even her very life.”

Kathi admits it has been a tough series to write. “The research is extensive and the emotional investment daunting. Yet I am certain that God has called me to do this, and there is great joy in knowing that you’re fulfilling God’s purpose by using His gifts as He has called you to do.” Her desire for her readers to walk away with more than just a few hours of entertainment is heartfelt. “More than anything I want readers to come away with a fresh challenge and commitment to serve Christ...at any cost. I want them to understand that the admonition in Hebrews to ‘remember those who are in chains as if chained with them’ is more than a suggestion. We not only need to make a complete heart commitment to our own faith, but we need to pray for and help those who are suffering as believers any way we can.”

Q&A: Randall Wallace

Randall Wallace is the author of seven novels, including the New York Times bestseller *Pearl Harbor*. He has written four feature films—*We Were Soldiers*, *Pearl Harbor*, *The Man in the Iron Mask* and the 1995 Academy Award-winner *Braveheart*. For his work on *Braveheart*, he received the Writers Guild of America Award for Best Original Screenplay. Wallace is the founder of Hollywood for Habitat for Humanity.

Q: What inspired you to write *The Touch*?

I was inspired while writing *The Touch* with the idea of having a gift. *Braveheart* was my first feature film and when it became a success story, I also understood that success could be one of the most dangerous challenges I'd ever faced; that to have a gift, even if the gift is of where you happen to be in your life—not even a question of your own talent—but to have that gift of time and place means that God has entrusted you with something. And the question was how freely you could give it, whether you could keep it by trying to hold back or whether you gained it by giving. As the Bible says, you gain your life by losing it.

I wanted to explore that part of life. In my other stories—*Braveheart*, *Pearl Harbor*,

We Were Soldiers, even in *Secretariat*—there's a sense of struggle and tragedy. I wanted to have this story be one of affirmation, be one of joy, be a story that when we read it, it was as if we were hearing "Ode to Joy" sung by a great choir.

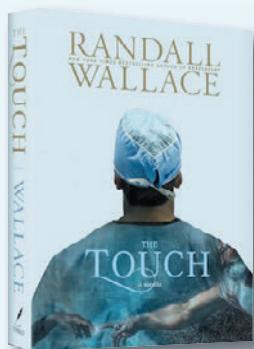
Q: What do you hope most readers will take away after reading *The Touch*?

What I hope most readers will take away after reading *The Touch* is, first of all, an emotional experience. I want them to feel something. My father once said to me, "People will remember almost nothing of what you say and only slightly more of what you do, but all their lives, they'll remember the way you made them feel." Well, I want readers to feel something in *The Touch*. I want them to have the experience of life and love, and faith lost and faith found. That's what I hope they'll experience, and I hope they'll take away not only that experience, but also an idea in their lives that to give when no one else knows, to give

in the way that would create—like Lloyd C. Douglas, who was the pastor of the church that we're sitting in right now—like what Lloyd C. Douglas wrote in *Magnificent Obsession*, that if you give when no one else knows you gave—not even the person who receives knows that you were the giver—that that will create in you an obsession to give again, a satisfaction deeper than you've ever known in your life, because what you've really experienced is unselfish love.

Q: Why do you think that story is such a powerful way to share truth?

Storytelling is the best form humans have ever found for conveying what really is true. Philosophy sits in the realm of ideas. Philosophy is thin and we can argue ideas, but a story strikes to our hearts. A story strikes to our identity. A story shapes who we are. And a story is not only created by the storyteller; it's created by the audience. An audience listens to the tale and responds



in a certain way, and that changes what the storyteller is telling. You know, we create the metaphors of our life and they become our guideposts of what is possible when we give a narrative of this life, this character that we believe could do this. And if they could do that, then maybe I can be like him or like her—I can love more, I can believe more, I can feel real joy. And this is in the realm of what I wanted *The Touch* to be. When I wrote *The Touch*, I wanted it to be kind of a gift from me to myself, a gift that I could give to others. I wanted to give not an idea but an experience—an experience of hope, an experience of life, an experience of love lost and love found. I wanted it to be a gift of joy.

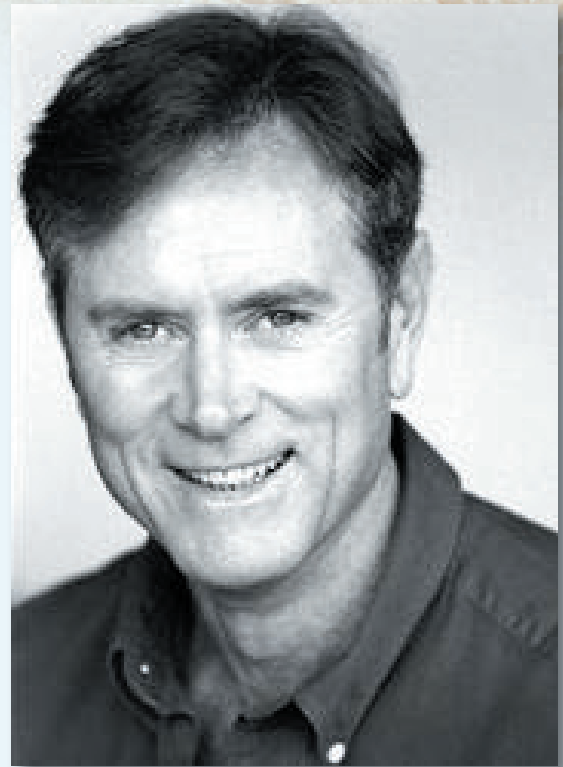
Q: Does being a screenwriter inform your fiction when writing for the page?

Being a screenwriter has helped me with my novels. It's interesting that I became known as a screenwriter before I was widely known as a novelist, but I was a novelist before I was a screenwriter. I write in a visual way, but I also make movies in an internal and an emotional way. When I'm doing a film like *Braveheart*, I want to find those moments that give me goose bumps, that make me weep or make me laugh, that make me feel joy and victory. And to do that, I think we've got to experience all the elements of a human life. Well, that's the way I write a story when I'm writing a novel like *The Touch*.

I want to take the reader through the life of the character. I want them to know what that character is going through even when they're not saying a word, what the character's heart is doing, and let the reader have that insight into the secret life of the character so that they can feel what a young surgeon is going through when he knows that the only thing between life and death for that patient is as narrow as the blade he's holding in his hand. And for a young woman who looks at this guy and knows that the life she's trying to hold on to is worthless unless she has love and faith, and she finds it through him, a gift even greater than life.

Q: Your screenplays are primarily historical military epics whereas *The Touch* is a contemporary medical drama. When approaching a project, how do you decide which story you want to tell and how you decide which is the best medium for your story?

I'm often asked why I tell stories that involve war and battles, and I always say, "I don't write war stories. I write love stories." I want to know what you love enough that you'd give your life for it, and I want to know what is sacred to

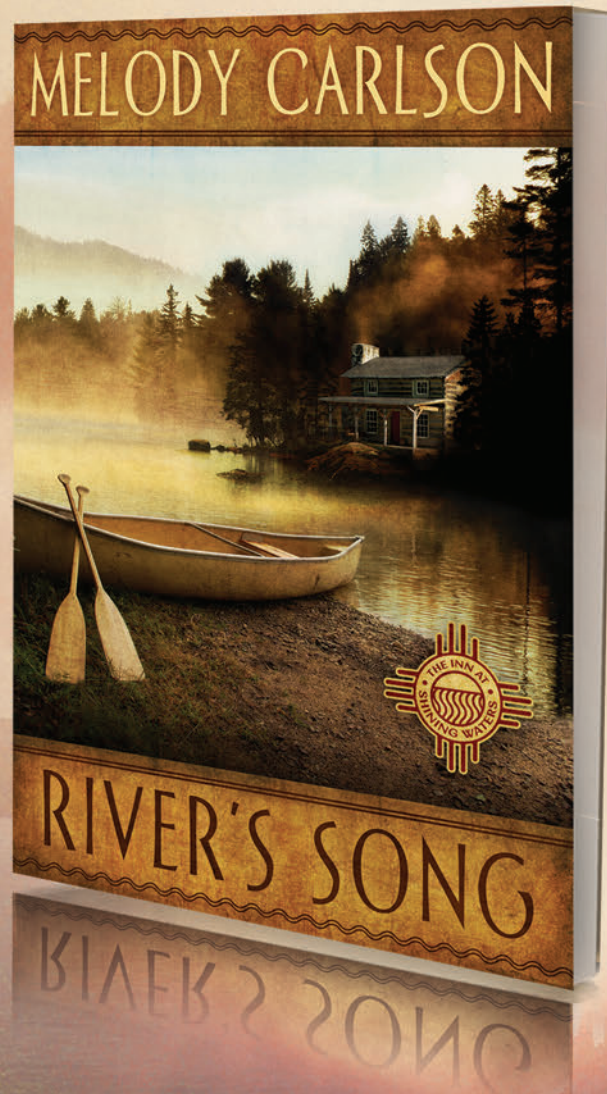

you so much that it's even more sacred than your heartbeat. And when I'm writing that kind of story, I think it really doesn't matter whether it's a movie or a book. I believe someday *The Touch* is going to be a wonderful movie, but it'll be a different experience to watch this story as a movie than it will be to read it. For me, I've always found novels to be the most intimate form of storytelling because in a novel, it's all occurring inside me. The characters are living behind my eyes instead of just in front of them, and that kind of story has the power to change me. When I was a young man, I would come out of a movie or close a book when I had finished reading it, on rare occasion, and think, *My life will never be the same because of what I've just experienced in that story.* And that's the kind of story I wanted *The Touch* to be.

Many authors use personal experience to inform their fiction—but for Kathleen Fuller, the writing was especially difficult this year.

Kathleen takes readers back to Middlefield with two new books: *Treasuring Emma* (Thomas Nelson), the first volume of the Middlefield Family series; and the young reader title *Hide and Secret* (Tommy Nelson), the third in her *Mysteries of Middlefield*.

In the Amish romance *Treasuring Emma*, the title character has put everyone else first in her life. Now nearly 25, has she missed her chance at marriage? A family saga and a story of forgiveness, the novel is a peek into the tightly knit community of the Amish.

The story is also driven by the author's personal trials: During the writing of *Treasuring Emma*, Kathleen was diagnosed with thyroid cancer. "As with most of my books, *Treasuring Emma* is about forgiveness," Kathleen wrote for *Romantic Times*. "But it's also about anger and resentment, emotions I dealt with as I was going through the process of understanding my cancer and undergoing treatment." While the novel is not about cancer, she says it touches on the universal emotions anyone

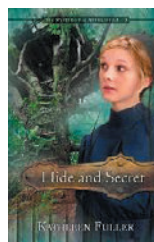
feels during different seasons of their lives.

It was a challenge to write *Treasuring Emma*, but Kathleen found that developing the characters helped her during her battle with cancer. "Through the character of Leona, I was able to conquer my own anxiety by reminding myself that God never abandons us, never forsakes us, and is always with us, even through times of extreme trial."

Kathleen's fiction is also featured in two recent collections: *What the Heart Sees*, with three of Kathleen's Amish romances together for the first time; and this December's *An Amish Wedding*, which stars three Amish women yearning for the perfect wedding. That collection includes novellas by Kathleen, Beth Wiseman and Kelly Long.

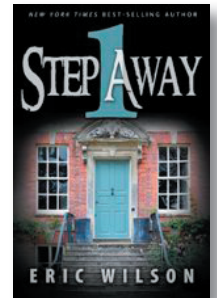


Eric Wilson refuses to be preachy. He's seen enough to know we need more than platitudes to turn hearts toward God.

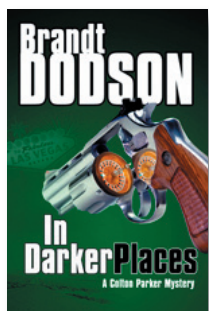

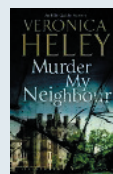

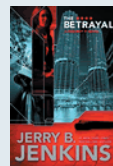

that relationship has been one of the treasures of my life.”

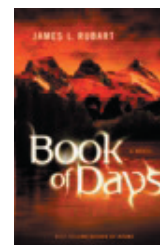

translate into passion for God.”

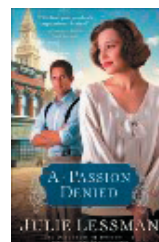

seems to bring me back to things He wants me to learn as I’m writing.”

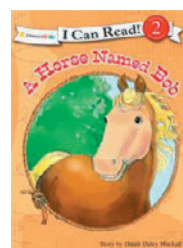

Craig Schutt, creator and writer of *Welcome to Holsom*, wants to create stories that tackle real world problems and can be used to start discussions about life and faith among readers.

As a comic book professional with experience working for DC Comics and Disney, it is no surprise what his chosen medium to present those stories would be. “I deeply believe in comics as one of the most effective means of communicating a message. The language of comics is universal, especially for kids,” Schutt explains.

That belief led him to create *Welcome to Holsom*, a comic book about “a small group of kids in a typical midwestern town who discover a secret underground complex that had been hidden away for half a century and they awaken a giant robot. In other words,” Schutt says with a grin, “it asks the question, ‘What would you do with a personal giant robot?’”

It asks other questions as well, tackling what Schutt calls “traditionally taboo topics” such as substance abuse, peer pressure, bullying, and even parenting issues.

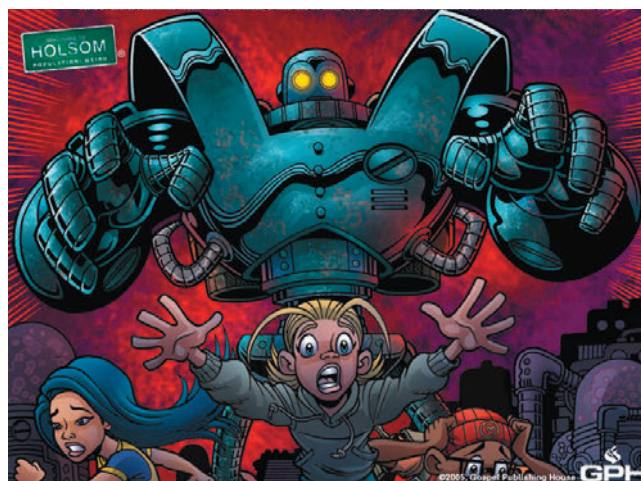
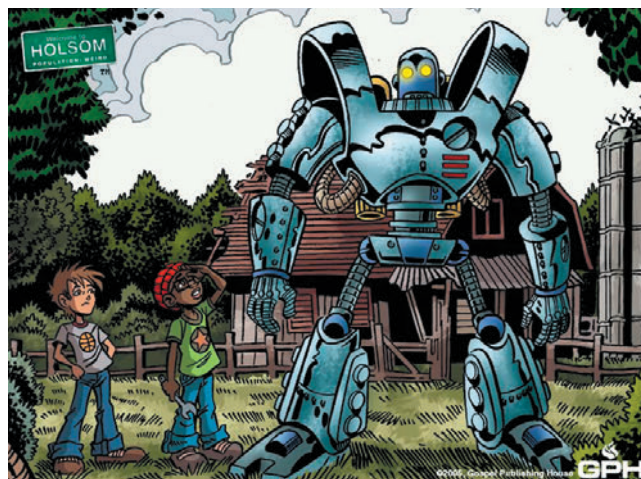
“It is one of those God things,” Schutt says, remembering *Holsom*’s beginnings. “I worked in comics for years and Assemblies of God was looking for new products that were contemporary minded. We wanted to tell a story that would be palatable to the Christian audience and yet say some serious things to the kids.”

5 Questions: MaryConnealy

Mary Connealy writes fun and lively “romantic comedy with cowboys” for the inspirational market. She lives on a ranch in eastern Nebraska with her husband, Ivan, and has four grown daughters. (Her alter-ego writes suspense novels under the pen name Mary Nealy.)



MARY CONNEALY

1. Tell us about *Out of Control*.

Julia Gilliland enjoys her outings to the cavern near her father’s homestead, where she explores for fossils and formations and plans to write a book about her discoveries. The cave seems plenty safe—until the day a mysterious intruder steals the rope she uses to climb her way out.



Rafe Kincaid is more intrigued by Julia than any woman he’s ever known. But when his developing relationship with Julia threatens his chance at reconciliation with his brothers, will he have to choose between the family bonds that could restore his trust, or the love that could heal his heart?

2. Why have you chosen to write about cowboys?

Cowboys in fiction take us to a time when good and evil were much more clearly separated; a time when one man would stand on his own to wrestle a living out of a hard land. The code of the West was about honor. It was about taking responsibility, protecting those weaker, especially women. It was about your word being your bond. Never quit, never rustle another man’s cattle or steal his horse. In these rules you’ll find the fundamentals of many of the Ten Commandments. So telling a cowboy story with a Christian worldview is simple.

3. Why did you set your book in the mountains of Colorado instead of the more traditional plains of Texas?

I was deeply moved by a visit to Carlsbad Cavern a few years ago. It truly is an awe-inspiring place. I needed mountains to hide the deep cavern. I couldn’t use the real Carlsbad Cavern—the history

of it is so well-known I knew I couldn’t treat this history with respect. In fact, I’d be trampling the truth with my book. But I found some other beautiful caverns in Colorado, as well as other places, and it gave me the nerve to create my own.

4. Your writing combines action, danger and comedy. How do you fit those unlikely elements into one story?

I have a recurring theme in my books that the West weeds out weaklings. This is a mindset I picked up from reading about a hundred Louis L’Amour books over and over: It was a hard land and the weak got out or died.

Throw in the love story, because I love a love story, and it figures you’ve got strong women teaming up with strong men. A battle is assured and sparks are going to fly. And comedy springs naturally from that.

5. What is the underlying theme of *Out of Control*?

You need to turn control of your life over to God. Rafe and Julia are both very much “take charge” kind of people. When they meet, they clash almost as strongly as they’re attracted to each other. Rafe hates the cavern and has spent his life trying to protect people from it. Julia believes God led her to the cavern and she’s not giving it up for a mere man. So why did God send her a man who is determined to stop her from fulfilling God’s will for her life?
